

Traffic Sign Matching

Draw a line from the traffic sign to the description that matches it.



- The sign is in the shape of a diamond.
- It is yellow and black.
- Means there are either bicycles or a bicycle crossing ahead.



- The sign is in the shape of two rectangles.
- It is green and white.
- Means there is a separate pathway for bicycles.



- The sign is in the shape of an octagon.
- It is red and white.
- Means to come to a complete stop at an intersection.



- The sign is in the shape of a pentagon.
- It is yellow and black.
- Means there is a school crosswalk.



- The sign is in the shape of a triangle.
- It is red and white.
- Means to stop only when necessary to avoid interference with other traffic that is given the right-of-way.



- The sign is in the shape of a circle.
- It is yellow and black.
- Means there is a railway crossing.
